

### The Wisdom of St. Paul

If there is no resurrection of the dead, then neither has Christ been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, then empty too is our preaching; empty, too, your faith. Then we are also false witnesses to God, because we testified against God that he raised Christ, whom he did not raise if in fact the dead are not raised. (1 Cor 15:13-15)

It's striking to see how Paul bases his argument on the real bodily Resurrection of Christ.

Sometimes we see this not as the proof, but as the problem. Was Christ really raised from the dead? Was the tomb really empty? And if it was, did some disciples steal the body?

For Paul (and the early Christians) these two questions presented no problem. Some had seen the risen Christ - and Paul himself was one of them. Others heard about it from those who had seen the risen Christ.

Think about it. These people who had encountered the risen Lord were not the type easily duped - least of all, Paul.

I might start my quiet reflection today on this very point. Have I, in my thoughts about death (we all think about our death) taken seriously and personally the fact that Christ went through death to risen, bodily life?

Is Christ really still alive? Do I really receive him, not just his memory, but his Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist?

Does Christ really send his Spirit upon me, present with me all day, all night?

Is Christ really – really, mind you – present with me now? Which is to say, I'm not alone in this room.
