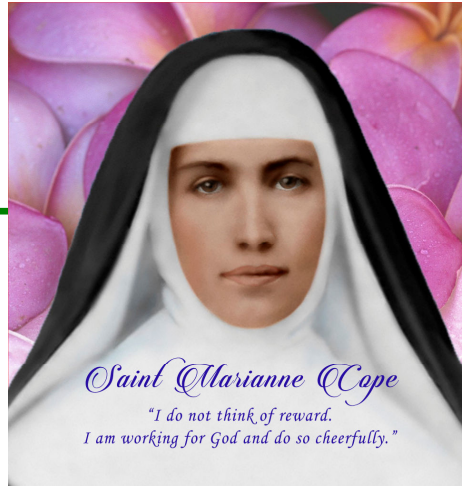

San Juan of Capistrano

St. John of Capistrano 1386 – 1456

John of Capistrano was born in 1386. A well-educated man in Civil Law, he was quite talented and successful. Appointed governor of Perugia, which included a strip of land across Italy, known as The Papal States. He was a married man. As a married man, he received a dispensation to enter the Franciscan Order. He was ordained a priest in 1420.

During a time of religious apathy in Europe, John devoted his time and ministry to preaching and hearing confessions. He is credited for reforming the Franciscan Order, together with St. Bernardine of Siena (1380-1444) and St. Colette (1381- 1447) who reformed the Franciscan Poor Clare nuns.

His greatest gift from God was the gift of preaching. He preached the Gospel in Hungary, Italy, France, Poland and Austria. He died in Villach, Austria on October 23, 1456. He rests in a tomb in Villach with this inscription on it: "This tomb holds John, by birth of Capistrano, a Man worthy of all praise, defender and promoter of faith, guardian of the Church, zealous protector of his Order, an ornament to all the world, lover of truth and justice, surest guide in doctrine; praised by countless tongues, he reigns blessed in heaven."

On the date of October 23rd, his feast day, the swallows return in droves to the California mission of Capistrano, which prompted the song by Pat Boone: "When the Swallows Come Back to Capistrano."
