The Wisdom of The Letter to the Hebrews

The sin of ignorance is pardonable; the sin of presump-

tion is not. Nevertheless, we must note that by the sin of ignorance the Jews meant more than simply lack of knowledge.

They included the sins committed when someone was carried away in a moment of impulse or anger or passion or was overcome by some irresistible temptation, and the sins were followed by repentance. By the sin of presumption, they meant the cold, calculated sin for which the perpetrator was not in the least sorry, the open-eyed disobedience of God.

So, the priest existed to open for sinners the way back to God – as long as they wanted to come back.

Priests must be at one with others. They must have gone through the same experiences and must be in full sympathy with others.
