

Candlemas Day

Traditionally, February 2nd is known as: <u>Candlemas Day</u>. The name should strike a familiar tone. Candlemas

Day reflects the fact that <u>candles are</u> <u>blessed at Mass</u> for private use in the home when gathering for prayer. Thus, the name: "Candlemas." Another very important religious day is: <u>Christmas</u>, or "Mass for Christ." Yet another, which has fallen by the wayside, is celebrated on September 29th and used to be known as: Michaelmas Day as it was the Feast of St. Michael only, and the harvest would soon be gathered. Michaelmas Day may have fallen out with the rearrangement of the liturgical Calendar after the close of Vatican 11 (1962-1965); That was when the Church placed St. Gabriel and St. Raphael <u>also</u> on September 29th, calling it the Feast Day of the Archangels. Prior to Vatican 11, St. Gabriel and St. Raphael had their own Feast Day with their own date, respectively. Today, we celebrate The Feast of The Presentation of the Lord. Or in its more ancient name, Candlemas Day. I will bless the candles today with a very simple blessing. <u>Please take one box per</u> family in order to give everyone a chance to have blessed candles in their home. If you have candles from previous years, you may want to consider not taking a box, so as to give someone else blessed candles for <u>their</u> home. You don't have to, but the option of making a donation is available. There is a little basket provided for you. God bless you!!

Blessing of the Throats

February 3rd is the traditional time in the Roman Catholic Church to "Bless Throats." <u>Today, throats will be blessed after Mass.</u> Please form two lines to have your throat blessed by either the Deacon or the Priest. There will be a common blessing and each individual is asked to come forward to be blessed and touched by the special St. Blaise Candles.

In the very early Church, St. Blaise was a Bishop who allegedly removed a fish bone lodged in the throat of a young boy by crossing two blessed candles and blessing the boy's throat. *"We pray that through intercession of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, we may be delivered from every ailment of the throat and every other disease."* Please don't think of this as some kind of magic! It is not! Ailments of the throat could also be gossip, swearing, malicious speech, wishing uncharitable or unchristian things on others, venomous and vitriolic hate that comes out of the mouth, etc., etc.

This week, I will be blessing the throats each day after the 12:15 Mass, for those who could not be here today. While one may receive this blessing more than once; please be careful not to abuse this beautiful custom, by turning it into magic.

Trusting in God and His Mercy helps us to heal and be protected, along with the prayers of St. Blaise.
