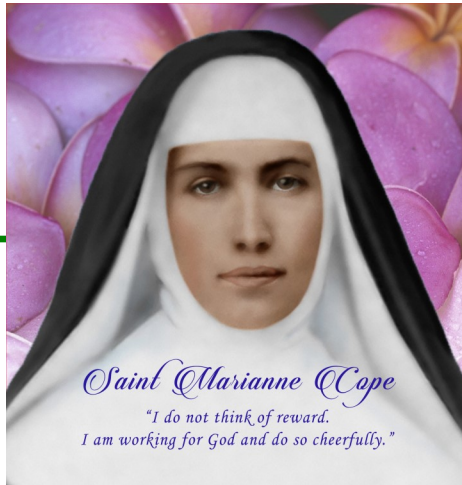

**REMINDER — REMINDER**

*Just a reminder: Sunday is the Lord’s Day. Mass on Sunday reflects the Lord Jesus, the Gospel and His mission. The saints and the Blessed Virgin Mary should not have a Mass on Sunday honoring them; or if someone received a favor through prayer. Those Masses should take place during the week; preferably on a day that is not a particular saints day. For instance; St. Anthony’s Feast Day is June 13th, we do not add a Mass in honor of Saint Therese on the Feast Day of St. Anthony. What do we do? Have a Mass in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary or a saint, for a favor received on a day that does not honor a particular saint. Those days without saints are called; “Ferial Days” (pronounced fair-ee-al).*

### Summer Missionary

Each year the Archdiocese assigns us a Summer Missionary who will speak on behalf of the Mission in a far part of the world. We learn about their needs and desires to support the Catholic Church and its growth in, sometimes remote places. This year we welcome back the Franciscans from India who will ask for support of The Franciscan Capuchins of Saint Joseph Province, India, in the Diocese of Nadukani Idukki. Please be generous to them, as you were last year. The following explains the needs of Saint Joseph Province, India.

**The Capuchin Friars of St. Joseph Province in Kerala, India**, is a Franciscan community committed to serving the poor, caring for creation, and nurturing spiritual renewal. The Province has been engaged in **mission outreach, education, ecological stewardship, and social upliftment** for decades, especially in the hilly regions of Kerala where vulnerable families—migrant farmers, tribal communities, and daily-wage laborers—struggle with poverty, climate instability, and limited opportunities.

One of the most significant initiatives is the mission at **Nadukani, Idukki**, where the Capuchins have lived a contemplative life of prayer since 1978. Over the years, this quiet friary in the mountains has grown into **Shola Woods**, a center dedicated to ecological studies, organic farming, and spiritual retreats. Through this mission, the Franciscans accompany local families, teach sustainable agriculture, support students through scholarships, and provide a space where people can rediscover God through creation.

Last year, your parish's generosity became a true blessing. Your support helped us **further develop the mission center**, strengthen our sustainable farming programs, and continue serving the poor families who depend on this ministry. We are deeply grateful. Your kindness has become part of the soil of Nadukani—quietly nourishing life, dignity, and hope.

As we look to this year's Mission Appeal, we are discerning a new step that aligns deeply with our Franciscan values of stewardship and justice. We hope to establish a **solar-energy project** at the mission center. This initiative will not only reduce our ecological footprint but also create **sustainable income opportunities for the poor families connected with the center**.

*Through this project, we aim to:*

- **Generate clean, renewable energy** for the mission and surrounding community
- **Create livelihood opportunities** for families who will help maintain and manage the system
- **Reduce long-term energy costs**, allowing us to reinvest savings into scholarships, food-security programs, and farmer support
- **Model ecological responsibility** for students, visitors, and local farmers

This project is not just about electricity—it is about **empowering the poor with dignity**, building resilience, and ensuring that our mission remains sustainable for years to come.

*Your parish has already walked with us in generosity and compassion. We humbly invite you to continue this journey with us as we take this next step toward a future where faith, creation care, and social upliftment grow together.*
